The afternoon session is for more experienced dancers who can confidently dance the main formations, including reels, poussettes and hello-goodbye setting. This knowledge will be assumed so the teacher can concentrate on developing further skills. Several of the figures taught will be drawn from the evening social dance programme.

It is expected that all participants will wear footwear appropriate for Scottish country dancing, such as ghillies.
